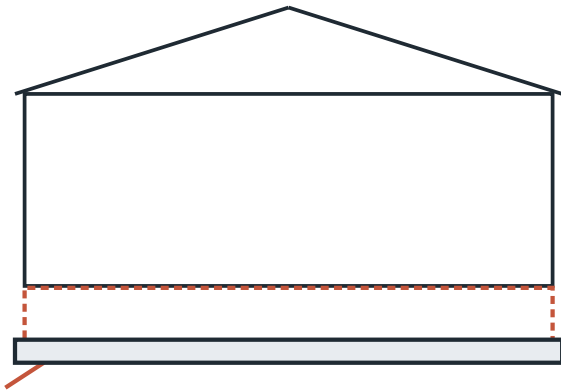


Earthquake Brace + Bolt Grant Readiness Checklist

Get ready to check whether you qualify for a retrofit grant. We do not decide eligibility; the program does.

After: bolted & braced

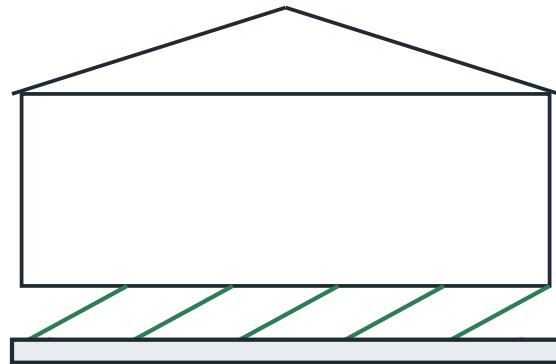


Illustration only. Whether a specific retrofit is right for your home can only be confirmed by a licensed contractor or engineer after an on-site assessment.

How grants like Brace + Bolt work

- California's Earthquake Brace + Bolt (EBB) offers up to about \$3,000 toward a qualifying retrofit.
- Eligibility depends on your home's location, age, and foundation type — the program decides, not us.
- Other states and FEMA hazard-mitigation programs offer similar help. Check what applies to you.

Checklist

- Confirm your ZIP code is in an eligible program area
- Confirm your home is the right age and foundation type for the program
- Gather your home's basic details (year built, square footage, foundation)
- Watch for the program's registration window — spots can be limited
- Find a contractor experienced with grant-funded retrofits
- Keep copies of your application and any photos
- Understand what the grant covers and what you pay
- Do not assume funds are guaranteed until the program confirms
