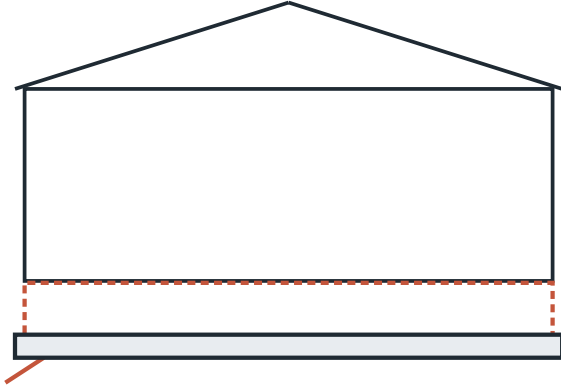


Retrofit Contractor Question Pack

After: bolted & braced

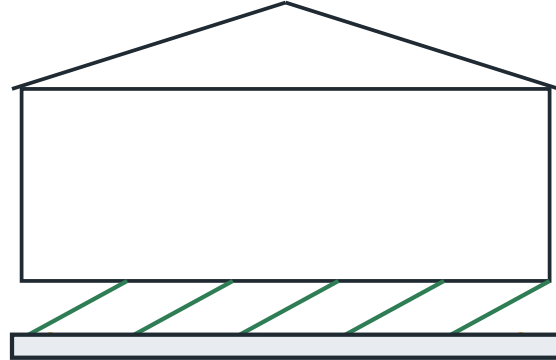


Illustration only. Whether a specific retrofit is right for your home can only be confirmed by a licensed contractor or engineer after an on-site assessment.

How to use these questions

- Ask the same questions of every contractor you talk to.
- Compare the answers side by side, along with the written scope and price.
- You compare and choose who to hire — confirm everything in writing first.

Checklist

- What weak points did you find in my home, and how did you check?
- Which retrofit work do you recommend, and which is optional?
- Do I need engineer's plans? Do I need a permit, and who pulls it?
- What is the written scope, and what is the written price?
- How long will the work take, and can I stay in the home?
- Are you licensed, bonded, and insured? May I see proof?
- Have you done retrofits like mine? Can I call references?
- Could this work qualify for a grant like Brace + Bolt?
- What is your payment schedule?
- What warranty or guarantee, if any, comes with the work?
